Rosy Berry	Llanfair	Used path without hindrance for 20 years. Notices are recent. Rosy copied her remarks to Eyrn and he has asked for more info. from her.
TJ Cecil Jones (Jenny)	Barmouth	Path used since 1950s. I don't remember there being gates at the end where the post box is, certainly never closed. No challenges. As a child holidayed in railway camping coaches at Arthog, Fairbourne and Llwyngwriil. We walked that path many times; this would be about 1953-1960.
Dick Yorke	Ceinws, Machynlleth	Walked estuary side for at least 25 years no challenge or notices
Ann Foley	Brithdir	I have walked in front of this terrace since 1980. As far as I remember there were no gates and I don't remember seeing FP signs directing people round the back. For last 10 years or so I think I have probably walked along here at least once a month. I do not remember when a gate appeared at one end, but I used to open the gate and go through it. I don't remember being verbally challenged. Later the gate was locked. Because I am old my memory for when things happened is very vague but I can say that I have used this residential road without secrecy, force or permission for more than 20 years.
Mary Davies	Dolgellau	Has walked the path for 35 years. Never been challenged. Cannot remember when any gates or barriers were erected but it was only a few years ago that a gate has been locked and a sign erected - maybe 5-6 years ago.
Derek Morgan	Barmouth	Has used the path for at least 40 years. About 8 years ago was accused of walking through the garden of the house nearest Barmouth. There was a gate at one time, up to about 10 years ago. The last time I walked in front of the Crescent about a month ago there was a combination lock on the gate nearest to Barmouth. Cannot remember when the 2 (stop) signs were first erected.
